

Espacio Tec is a museum dedicated to describing the history and evolution of information technology around the world, particularly in Argentina, a process in which the city of Bahía Blanca - where the museum is located - played a singular role.

Drawing on a large and ever growing collection of computer equipment, consoles and calculating machines, the museum aims to establish a permanent exhibition in a multipurpose space capable of hosting a range of activities, including exhibitions, and meetings of related groups and organizations, in addition to museum functions such as the implementation of a volunteer program, restoration projects, and collaboration with other institutions in the fields of science, technology, art and design.

Espacio Tec is currently the largest live and interactive computer museum in Argentina. Every Saturday, visitors can appreciate a large collection of machines and technological artifacts, as well as viewing and interacting with dozens of computers, consoles and other functioning devices, a factor that sets Espacio Tec apart from traditional museums.
